NORTH INCH JUNIOR GOLF CLUB - CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/CARERS

As a parent/carer of a junior member you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct.

You should:

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with club staff/officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance and effort, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in golf.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their golf.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Never use threatening or abusive behaviour or language towards children, officials, coaches or other parents.
- Always notify the Organiser if your child will not be attending or is going to be late for a coaching session/competition at which they are expected.
- Ensure that the Club is made aware of any pre-existing medical conditions your child has.
- Ensure that all correspondence and consent forms are replied to by the due date.
- Ensure that your child is dropped off and picked up on time after each session.
- Ensure your child is prepared for sessions, with appropriate clothing etc.,
- Only take photographs of other children if the proper consent of those children and their parents has been granted.
