NORTH INCH JUNIOR GOLF CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

As a junior member you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- Participate within the rules.
- Respect the decisions of coaches and organisers.
- Treat others as you would wish to be treated yourself and respect your opponents.
- Keep to the agreed times for coaching sessions and competitions and inform coaches/starter when you are going to be late.
- Demonstrate fair play and apply golf's standards both on and off the course.
- Respect physical, cultural and racial differences.
- Tell someone in authority if you are leaving a venue or competition.
- Treat organisers, coaches, and other Club Members with respect.
- Have a positive commitment to coaching and attend as many sessions as possible to help you to fulfil your potential and your enjoyment of golf.

You should not take part in any irresponsible, abusive, inappropriate or illegal behaviour which includes:

- Consuming alcohol or illegal or performance-enhancing drugs or stimulants.
- Smoking.
- Using foul language.
- Publicly using critical or disrespectful descriptions of others (including social media).
- Actions which may endanger the Health and Safety of another member or guest / child of the club.
- Improper Conduct including fighting, victimisation and harassment.
- Deliberate damage to club or members' property.
- Taking any photographs/videos of others in areas where personal privacy is important such as changing rooms and bathrooms.
